Spring & Summer Term	How will we monitor progress? Children will be able to tell what 5Rs are. Collect, count and recycle batteries. Year 5&6 have a lesson about recycle and whole school assembly. Bins are labelled and children using correct bins.
Aim: To reduce waste and encourage recycling		Who is responsible? Eco-coordinator, Headteacher & other staff.	Evaluation: Children are helping to empty the bins and using correct bins for fruit, paper and plastic. Can talk about recycling plastic and batteries and reusing clothes and understand that batteries can be harmful to our environment. Collected, counted and recycled all the batteries almost 2000!
